

KCC vs. RBSC Hockey Interport

The 2011 Hockey Interport with the Royal Bangkok Sports Club took place at King's Park on Friday, 20 May.

The KCC team, captained by Eamonn Marley, was drawn from A, B, C, D and E team players, a fine mix of talent for this annual match, whilst the Bangkok side, managed by Thanisorn, had an equally good selection of oldies and youngsters, with Anong as Captain.

Old hockey stalwarts, Jimmy Keir and Mike Kennedy were presented to both sides, led out by match official A D Dad and umpires Patrick Wong and Iqbal Khan.

The ambient temperature and humidity dropped to a more pleasant level by the time the match started early evening and any hint of rain did not materialise.

KCC, with coach Harry Bal pulling the strings in midfield, were quickly into their stride and tested the visiting goalkeeper a few times before opening the scoring in the 9th minute. Certainly RBSC's goalie, a veteran of these Interports, seemed to be struggling with his protective gear and had no chance when Zaki and Jamie crashed home another couple of goals to have the home side leading 3-0 at half time.

Both sides used their squads on a rotating basis and also 'Big' Don made way for the silky Sethi in goal for the second half.

KCC continued where they left off and continued to probe the RBSC midfield and defence. However the Bangkok boys had



quite a few chances themselves to reduce the deficit, whilst possibly remembering the six goals KCC netted last July.

With the supporters in the stand willing our visitors on, especially the vociferous Patrick PE, KCC continued their onslaught with further well taken goals from Toby, Bobby and Matt to make it 6-0.

Then following a few near misses RBSC (Peerapong) scored from a penalty corner with almost the last hit of the game to make the score identical to last year's fixture.

Players and supporters then returned to KCC for the usual friendly get-together in the Pavilion. After some fine food and

beverages, presentations were made. KCC retained the Interport trophy, Jamie won the KCC fair player award, Harry the best player, Kittipong as RBSC's fair player and Wongamart their best player award.

Whilst it was as usual great, not only to see our good friends from Bangkok but also to be able to repay some of their excellent hospitality, it was noted that KCC has not sent a squad to Bangkok for an Interport for some time. Certainly our hockey hierarchy acknowledges the lack of trips to RBSC in recent years and there was a collective call for a return Interport at RBSC this year, rather than waiting till 2012. August was mooted for this with a good backing from many in attendance. So let's now make a big effort to make it happen.
